BACKGROUND INFO

Since starting Stafford Boys in January 2016, I have received a lot of requests to sponsor a boy through high school. Stafford gives the boychild the chance to quality and affordable education (where they shine in both academics and talents).

I am overwhelmed by heartbreaking stories of young boys who have to do manual jobs during the holidays to not only fend for their families but also pay for their own school fees. Some are from large families or are being brought up by single parents who don't have any means to pay their fees.

When they report to school with no soap or other personal effects and tattered uniform, the urge to take care of them and give them a chance to go to school becomes impossible to resist.

However, since we are a young school it has become hard for us financially to sponsor more. We are currently fully sponsoring 4 boys in the school. We still keep some in school and allow their parents to pay their fees in small instalments throughout the year. Unfortunately, we have had 9 drop outs in the academic year 2017 due to financial constraints.

In Stafford, we are keen on assisting the boys know and live their God given purpose. We also mentor and teach them right values to be men of integrity and purpose. We support them through their struggles and provide a conducive environment for learning. My cry goes out to all the boys who would really love to be part of Stafford but their parents can't afford the fee.
